Welcome to Term 1 2024

Pick up Times - If you have children who are only in Rooms 4, 6, 7, 8, or 9 please pick them up at 2:45pm from outside Room 8. We ask for prompt and quick collection to help ease congestion in the car park.

If you are collecting children from Rooms 1, 2 and 5 or children in both Senior and Junior School, pick up time is 3pm from the lunch bay, under the shade sails. Please don't arrive earlier as we are trying to ease congestion in the car park.

Out of School Care - We are very blessed to have Kelly Club at our school. If you are needing to drop your children to school before 8:30 am please book them into Kelly Club (this is a paid service). We will be taking children there for supervision if they arrive to school before 8.30am, and you will be invoiced. Classes are only supervised from 8:30 am due to meetings we have before school.

After school children must be collected by 3:15pm, if not they will be taken to Kelly Club and once again you will be invoiced. Staff are in meetings from 3:15pm.

Kelly Club is operating from the space between Rooms 8 and 9. They have got great programmes lined up and provide a snack for your children in the afternoon.
