Masks - Years 4 to 8

(Because Room 6 is a combination class, we will not enforce mask wearing, but those students who wish to, may definitely wear their mask.)

Please ensure your child brings a mask to school every day.

Please ensure that the masks fit properly. Some students are wearing the adult blue masks which are too big for their face – and thus do not provide any protection. You can tie a knot at the end of the elastic to ensure a better fit.

Any cloth masks must be named, so when left lying outside, these can be returned.

At most times, students do not need to wear masks outside, but there are occasions when students are outside – along with large groups of parents. In these cases, students have been asked to wear their masks for their own safety.

Smoke Free and Dog Free

Southcity, like all schools in New Zealand, is a Smoke Free Zone – and no smoking or vaping is allowed on our premises. It is now illegal to smoke in your car with children in it – or I expect, before picking up children who will travel in your car.

Southcity is also dog free. Please do not bring your dog and walk them to pick up your child. If you <u>have</u> to have your dog in the car, please ensure that the windows are mostly up – so that the dog cannot frighten children. Also remember how hot a car can become in a short space of time. Perhaps leave the dog at home.
