From the Principal;

Kia ora koutou katoa (Greetings to you all).

A big thank you to those parents who are keeping their children home when sick, and to those who have notified us when their child has tested positive. The Ministry of Education requires us to notify them of daily positive numbers of students and staff.

We continue to be reminded that the Covid peak has not yet reached us. When it does, we could be in a tricky situation if large numbers of staff become infected. Please be advised in advance, that should many staff become infected at the same time, we may have to take drastic measures regarding school attendance. What this may look like is uncertain at this time – but it may be an inconvenience to you!

Also, please note that should our case numbers increase dramatically, I may be unable to notify you of these as I have done in the past.

We hope and pray that all those who are currently infected are not too unwell, and are returned to full health in record time.

Just a reminder too, that the isolation period has been reduced to 7 days. Household contacts need to test on Day 3 and Day 7, and if negative and symptom free, may return to school on Day 8. Day 0 is the day that symptoms start, or the day you test positive.
