We request that your holidays be planned during the school holidays where possible.

Covid / Omicron

We are aware that some students were infected with Covid over the school holidays. If your child was one of these cases, please can you let Lisa know, so we can keep our data tracking up to date. We had one staff member who unfortunately spent part of their holiday isolating as well.

Please continue to keep your children home when they are sick. By doing this, we ensure that as many students and staff are able to stay well. You must advise the school office via email, app, or phone each day that your child is not attending school.

All positive Covid cases must still isolate for 7 days. Day 0 is the day that symptoms started or when you test positive. Isolating students may attend school from the 8th day. They do not need a further test to leave isolation.

Please continue to advise the school of any positive cases in your household.

Masks are encouraged but not required (at Orange) when students are at school. At Southcity, students in Years 4 to 8 will no longer be expected to wear masks in class, but they may continue to wear them if they wish to.

The school is happy to provide masks for these students (available from their class teachers).

Please can all adults on site wear masks when visiting / dropping off or picking up students.

School Uniform

Please ensure that students wear the correct uniform to school each day. The correct shoes (plain black sandals or closed shoes) must be worn <u>to</u> school and <u>home</u> each day.

Parents please check your child is <u>wearing</u> correct school shoes before they leave home in the morning or leave school in the afternoon.

Please name <u>all</u> clothing, including shoes.

Car Park Safety

Our car park is a very busy place. Please do not cross it or walk along the centre of it at any time. Cross only at the narrowest point outside the office.

Walk along the gravel pathways provided on the field side and road side. Do not take a short cut to your car.

Keep your child/ren alongside you at all times.

Please advise all people who pick up / drop off your children, of these safety rules.

Foodbank

A box has been placed under the table in the office foyer, to collect any non-perishable foodstuffs for the Foodbank. If you are able to add a little extra to your shopping basket each week, and provide assistance to those less fortunate, we would be very grateful.

This will be an ongoing collection and the box will be cleared regularly.

Adults in the Classrooms

From the start of this term, adults will be allowed access into our classrooms.

You are welcome to assist your child with hanging up their bag etc. and settling them into class.

We do request that any conversations with other parents happen outside of the classroom. The teacher may ask you to head outside if you forget.

If you wish to talk to the teacher, please remember that they will be unable to assist you while they are trying to teach. It is preferable to make an appointment for a time when they can give you their full attention.

With a change to the numbers of people allowed together indoors, we are allowed to hold our assemblies again.

Our first assembly will be held this Friday, the 6th of May at 2.10pm in Room 9. Parents and extended family are welcome to attend. Further assemblies will be held fortnightly.

Assemblies will finish by 2.45pm, to ensure those parents who pick up their children earlier, are able to do so.

We do prefer that you do not interrupt our assembly to pick up earlier than this.
