If you are collecting children from Rooms 1, 2 or 5 or children in both Senior and Junior School, pick up time is 3pm from the lunch bay. Please don't arrive earlier as we are trying to ease congestion in the car park. We appreciate your help in this matter.

**Student Information Sheet** – The details that we have on file for your child will be sent home today via an email from Edge. Please check all the details carefully, and email the school office if there are any changes or additions to be made. Please ignore the EOTC Permission tick box as we do not use this at Southcity. If you do not email the office, we will assume that all the details we have are correct.

Out of School Care – Over the last couple of weeks we have fielded emails regarding the before school care arrangements. School is open for children to attend from 8:30am if they are not booked into Kelly Club. Establishing a before and after school care programme on site at our school was initiated because of parent requests. When surveys went out the response was very favourable. Many people said they would enrol their child. I am very aware that finances are tight but my priority is to ensure that your child is safe and cared for. My staff cannot provide supervision before 8:30am. I have a duty of care to ensure the safety and well-being of all at this school. This is the best scenario to achieve this. If you are needing to drop your children to school before 8:30 am please book them into Kelly Club (this is a paid service). We will be taking children there for supervision if they arrive to school before 8.30am, and you will be invoiced.

After school children must be collected by 3:15pm, if not they will be taken to Kelly Club and once again you will be invoiced. Staff are in meetings from 3:15pm. Kelly Club is operating from the space between Rooms 8 and 9. They have got great
